

# *Name Your Documents....Quiz, Quiz, Trade cards*

These cards can be used with the Kagan strategy, Quiz Quiz Trade to help students learn the important documents of the colonial American period.

Print Options:

You have two options to print the cards.

1. Pixie 3 – Open each card in Pixie3 and print out using the “table tent” option. This will print both pages on the same sheet of paper. The page will be printed so that you can fold the card and view each side with the text turned right side up. It is recommended that you print the cards on a sheet of paper, fold in half and laminate.
2. PDF – You can use the PDF format to print the cards from a color printer that allows you to print on both sides of the paper. Print out on card stock paper and laminate.
